

Topic
 In our topic work, we will be finding out about life in Ancient Egypt. We will learn about what was important to their daily lives, who Tutankhamun was and how mummies were made. The children will also learn about Egyptian Gods and how Egyptian people used hieroglyphics to communicate.



RE
 In RE, we will be looking at stories about Jesus performing miracles. We will be learning to recall key events in the Easter story and understand why Jesus' crucifixion symbolises hope for Christians.



ART and DT
 We will use "The Ancient Egyptians" as inspiration for our artwork this term. We will explore different techniques to create Egyptian necklaces, scarabs and mummies.



PSHE
 We will be following PATHS and exploring how to create a learning environment that helps us to learn together happily and safely.



PE
 In PE, we will be developing our skills and teamwork in tag rugby and hockey. We will also be taking part in dance and yoga.



English
 In English, we will be writing adventure stories, diary accounts, instructions and explanations. We will be using information texts and producing our own non-chronological reports relating to our topic work. We will regularly be practising spelling, punctuation and grammar.

COMPUTING



We will use the Internet to research relevant aspects of our topic. We will learn to use spreadsheets and introducing touch typing.

SCIENCE
 As scientists, we will be learning about Light and Shadows: how they are formed and how they can be changed. We will also be learning about animals including humans, looking at nutrition, skeletons and muscles. We will be asking questions, setting up practical enquiries and making observations.



MATHS
 As mathematicians, we will read, write, partition, compare and order numbers. We will continue to develop methods for all 4 number operations, and use these to solve real-life problems. We will use knowledge of the properties of 2D and 3D shapes to classify them. We will use appropriate units to measure length, mass and capacity. We will read analogue and digital times and calculate time intervals. We will also recognise, find and write fractions.



GERMAN
 As linguists, we will be learning to greet each other and have simple conversations in German



MUSIC
 As musicians, we will sing, play instruments and find out about pulse, rhythm and pitch. Our themes are "The Dragon Song" and "Three Little Birds"
