HOMEWORK

All homework will be set on Google Classroom. Homework will usually be set on a Friday.

Children will be given spellings to learn (they will be tested in school every Friday).

The children will also be given a times table target and will be tested every Thursday.

Please continue to read with your child **at least 3** times a week. Children will be responsible for making sure they choose a new reading book when needed.

PE KIT

Monday: indoor yoga

Friday: outdoor PE

Children require the following kit for PE:

- **White** T-shirt;
- **Black** shorts (warm weather only)
- Trainers
- Jogging bottoms and sweatshirt / hoody

Children will be required to come to school dressed in their PE kits every Monday and Friday. If children forget to wear their PE kit to school we will phone parents and ask you to bring your child's kit into school. Any child not wearing PE kit will unfortunately not be allowed to participate in the lesson.

All earrings should be removed for PE (or covered in tape supplied by the children) and long hair must be tied back. For health and safety reasons, children will not be permitted to take part in PE lessons if they are wearing earrings

Stationery: All children will be required to bring their own pencil cases to school. These will remain in school until the end of term.

Snack: Please could children bring in their own healthy snack every day (only fresh fruit or veg is permitted).

Water bottles: These need to be washed and refilled at home and brought to school every day. We will not be able to provide children with a drink. We will phone parents if children come to school without a water bottle.
