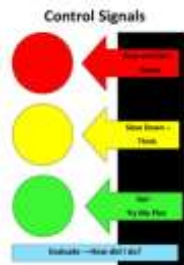

We will be learning about The Stone Age through to the Iron Age and comparing what we have found to the parallel aspects of life in Ancient China and their contributions to society. We will learn about the skills used by archaeologists and how different types of evidence can be interpreted and how this informs us about the lives in these Ancient civilisations. We will be developing our understanding of chronology and ordering events using a timeline.

#### English

We are writing 'to describe' this half term. Using our class book 'Wolf Brother', we will be learning how to take notes and then develop these bullet points into summaries of description. We are focusing on using rich language in the style of this author - Michelle Paver - to write a description of a dramatic event in the book. Drama will play a key role in the planning stage. We will also use the features of non-fiction, in a non-chronological report, to create a piece of writing about Stone Age Homes. Next half term, we will be writing to discuss. We will be debating the question: 'Which Ancient Civilisation left a more important legacy: The Stone Age or The Shang Dynasty? We will use this as a basis for planning and writing a balanced argument. We will also be reading Tales from China and enjoying the Willow Pattern Story.
