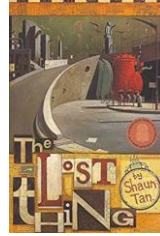
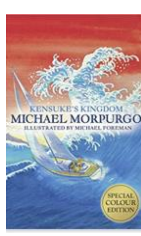


# Y5 Curriculum Overview

### Geography

Working as Geographers, we will be learning about how the world is represented on maps. We will become confident in labelling the different continents and be able to locate and name different countries and cities across the globe as well as using terms including longitude and latitude. Using atlases and maps, we will investigate how land is used in different ways and how settlements are affected by such factors. We will be learning about different biomes and then focusing in upon the Geography of the local area: it's planned growth and sustainability.

### English

We are writing 'to entertain' this half term and 'to persuade' in the following half term. We will be reading stories written by Shaun Tan to inspire diary entry writing and will be using the drama technique of hot-seating to explore a character's feelings.
